Read:- 1. Letter No. SIRC/PD/21-08 dated 13.06.2008 of Chairman, Southern India Regional Council of the Institute of Cost and Works Accountants of India.

**ORDER**

In the letter read above, it is intimated that ICWAI (The Institute of Cost & Works Accountants of India), which is a statutory body, established by an Act of Parliament conducts ICWAI courses for students. The institute has five chapters in Kerala which together enroll about 500 students every six months. As per the new norms of the ICWAI curriculum every student has to undergo three years compulsory practical training after the intermediate stage and requested the State Government to utilise the services of the students as trainees in the Local Self Government Department.

Government have examined the request in detail and are pleased to enroll three trainees in each of the Corporations and two trainees in each of the district headquarter Municipality and one trainee each in SIRD, KILA and KURDFC on a pilot basis. After three months, if the experiment is successful a proper scheme will be developed in consultation with ICWAI and made applicable to all institutions.

Government are also pleased to order that the trainees will be given a minimum stipend as follows from the operational expenses of the concerned institutions.

1<sup>st</sup> year - Rs.3,000/- per month

2<sup>nd</sup> year - Rs.3,500/- per month

3<sup>rd</sup> year - Rs.4,000/- per month
